

## **TAG MEETING MINUTES**

**1) Meeting commenced 1005 on 19 March 2009**

**2) Motion approved to accept 19 February 2009 minutes: PSNS IMF**

**3) Second: AOPS**

**4) MOTORCYCLE PARKING BLDG 995:** Kenneth Malich (IFPTE) received complaints about ships force without decals parking in Lot 995. The lot is outside the gate and access is not controlled. MMC Walter (Parking Enforcement) will increase enforcement efforts. Mr. Malich stated there are no designated motorcycle areas in Lot 995 and asked if they are allowed to park in SOV spaces. MMC replied that motorcycles are authorized in designated motorcycle areas only.

**5) WAITING LIST FOR LOTS:** Mr. Malich is still waiting on the link that lists individuals assigned to designated parking without violating PPI. MMC stated anyone can go to the parking building and view the list. The list changes daily so it would not be accurate to print out. Mr. Malich stated he can help parking with this list and be an extra set of eyes to ensure personnel are still actively employed. OPSO supports this idea. Richard Panzer (C260M) stated there is no map on the website to identify parking lots Sandra D'andrea (NAVFAC) will e-mail the parking map to him. AOPS is working on making the map available on the website.

**6) STRIPING G-LOT FINAL SUBMISSION:** Mrs. D'andrea is waiting for final decision on restriping of G lot and relocating the vanpool spaces in April 09. G-lot will be first on the list for restriping after the crosswalks which are being completed for safety reasons. Mr. Malich asked if parallel motor cycle parking can be permitted in G-Lot by the steam pipes. Mrs. D'andrea stated no, as this would create a traffic flow problem and SOV's would back into the vehicles. Mr. Malich requested if the striping in the vanpool stalls can be widened. Mrs. D'andrea stated if the spaces are widen the number of spaces would be reduced. By relocating and striping the spaces, they will be wider and more accessible. There are 38 van stalls. Mrs. D'andrea will talk to Don Reed to find out the Federal Standard size for SOV and will provide at the next meeting. Final submission for striping G-Lot pending outcome of this information.

**7) NEW BUS STOP REQUEST:** Mr. Malich apologizes that he has not yet met with Marie Campbell.

**8) RAILROAD USAGE:** AOPS addressed as FYI. There will be a team working along the railroad tracks. OPSO stated it will not affect anyone.

**9) HANDICAP PARKING:** Mr. Malich addressed the lack of handicap parking in F-lot. 20 handicap spaces were allegedly removed from F lot when the F-lot striping was reconfigured. MMC stated those 20 spaces are now included in the handicap parking lot located adjacent Z-lot. This handicap lot is the only lot where open designated handicap parking is available. All other lots without a designated pass will be ticketed. Patricia Brewer-Hart (NBK Parking Coordinator) stated there are approximately 150 Handicap parking spots in Z-Lot.

**10) OPEN FLOOR:**

**A)** Thad Johnson (PSNS Security) stated 140 workers will be coming from Norfolk, VA to help with the USS Abraham Lincoln. Mr. Johnson requested if parking can accommodate car pool passes in H-Lot for them. The workers will be using rental cars and vanpool. MMC stated as long as they go through the Kitsap Transit and if parking is available, there shouldn't be a problem and will accommodate.

**B)** OPSO stated that there is an F-Lot project to install a truck run off lane that will commence around August-September 2009. Mrs. D'andrea stated she hasn't seen the final design yet.

**C)** OPSO mentioned that the BEQ parking garage will be finished around December 2009. Mrs. D'andrea asked if there were any plans for use of the remaining Cottman Lot (currently being used as a lay down) after the project is done. Mr. Malich inquired when the 80 spaces currently provided in the north end of Montgomery lot would be returned to other available parking.

**D)** OPSO mentioned the 985/853 Electrical Loop project will commence in early March and will be finished October 2009. Some parking may be affected in D lot, (Navy College Lot).

**E)** MMC asked to please pass along; anyone in receipt of a parking pass NOT loan it to anyone. Parking will be strongly enforcing this and anyone loaning their pass will be suspended for fraudulent pass use.

**F)** Mr. Panzer stated people are trying to sneak into the 1105 parking garage after 2<sup>nd</sup> shifters enter the gate and it is a security issue. This happened is 1300-1430. AOPS suggested to call DOD police and report it when witnessed. MMC stated there is a security phone inside the elevators in the parking garage.
